### Directions By Car From Chester

Drive along the A55 towards Conway and Bangor. Exit at junction 16 signposted Penmaenmawr. Drive straight through the village of Penmaenmawr along Bangor Road for approx 1 1/4 miles, until you reach a park on your left (Parc Plas Mawr). Bangor Road now becomes High Street. Lyme Cottage is on your left just past a pedestrian light, opposite the Victoria Garage forecourt.

### Directions By Car From Bangor

Drive along the A55 towards Conway. Exit at junction 15A signposted Penmaenmawr. Drive over the bridge over the A55, then turn right at the T Junction. A little further along this road you will find Lyme Cottage on your left just past a pedestrian light, opposite the Victoria Garage forecourt.

There are double yellow lines and pedestrian zig-zag lines here, but the police are amenable to my guests unloading their cases outside the door before being shown either to my private parking area at the rear of the house or to nearby parking bays.

### By Bus

National Express run services from city centres all over Great Britain to Llandudno and Conwy. There are local buses to bring you all the way to Penmaenmawr, but we can collect you by car from the coach station if you tell us the time of arrival.
